# **MILLBURY RUBBISH REMOVAL CURBSIDE RECYCLING SERVICE**

## **GLASS**

### **Glass bottles/jars - clear, green and brown**

Preparation: rinse clean and remove lids, collars, neck rings and corks  
paper labels may stay on

**NO** broken glass or other glass items such as window glass, dishes, glasses  
Pyrex, ceramics, light bulbs

## **METAL**

### **Aluminum/tin/steel cans and lids Deposit and non-deposit beverage cans**

Preparation: rinse clean, flatten (if possible), labels may stay on

**NO** aluminum foil, foil trays, aerosol cans or hazardous material

## **PLASTIC**

### **Plastic containers labeled "1" and "2"**

Preparation: empty and rinse clean, flatten, remove and discard lids with trash

**NO** plastic bags, toys or motor oil containers
